Evaluation task force report – 30 August 2021

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Observations

- Education committee is a non-technical committee. It plays a major role in our SO2 and SO3.
- More and more active members for several years -> good participation and efficient work (core group of around 12-15 extremely active members).
- Covid-19 crisis has not affected the work of the committee as remote collaboration worked really well.
- Background of members: actuaries working in insurance companies (approx. 50%) and teachers (approx. 50%).
- Two meetings per year via MS Teams; interaction via e-mail

Main goals 2021 -2022 and recommendations

- Review of the AAE syllabus : insisting on the promotion of international skills – AAE has to empower associations to establish standards locally. How to do that?
- Contributing to the discussion on the MRA : transition period of “MA does not fulfil request” in particular -> We should launch a joint task force ProfCom / EduCom
- IA/ DataScience : defining the position of the AAE : CPD or Core syllabus -
> requiring feedback from Local market/MAs, link with Esko’s WG

Note : most of active members of the education committee are also members of the IAA, so they will monitor worldwide different educational changes, by design
