

## ***Quarterly Report – Education Committee***

### *Meetings of the Education Committee*

On 11 April 2019 a meeting of the Education Committee took place in Sofia, Bulgaria. Representatives from 15 different associations joined the meeting. The next meeting will take place on 10 October 2019 in conjunction with the 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting of the AAE in Vienna, Austria. It is also planned to have a joint meeting with the Professionalism Committee on CPD matters.

### *Vice-Chair*

The vacant position of the Vice-Chair of the Education Committee was discussed at the meeting of the Committee in Sofia. Rafael Moreno Ruiz (Instituto de Actuarios Españoles and member of the Committee since 2012) was proposed to take over this role and was unanimously supported by the Committee.

The AAE Board followed this recommendation and appointed Rafael Moreno Ruiz to take over the role as Vice-Chairperson of the AAE Education Committee.

### *European Congress of Actuaries 2019 (ECA 2019) – Programme Committee*

Several members of the Education Committee supported the ECA 2019 in the Programme Committee for the congress. The Programme Committee set up the structure and the content for the 36 breakout sessions based on 84 submissions through a call-for-papers in late 2018. 2/3 of all participants stated that the congress programme, which was finalised one week prior to the opening of the registration, was the main reason to join the ECA.

Several members of the Education Committee also contributed to the huge success of the congress with own presentations or taking over the role as session chair.

### *AAE Core Syllabus*

The Syllabus Review Task Force is making good progress.

A proposal for Core Syllabus Guidelines was sent to the members of the Education Committee. Different feedback was received which needs to be discussed in the next couple of weeks.

In addition to that a small Task Force of the Education Committee is working on proceedings for the future audit process to check compliance of members associations with the requirements of the AAE Core Syllabus.

In the beginning of May a webinar on the proposed new AAE Core Syllabus took place. Almost 50 participants received some general information on the AAE Core Syllabus and the current draft status.

### *CPD Strategy*

Together with the Professionalism Committee a joint Task Force on CPD has been established to review AAE's CPD strategy. The Task Force will present its report to both Committees in July 2019.
