Walking tours:

1. “Kings & Vikings Tour”

Date: Wednesday 20 September 2017 or Friday 22 September 2017

Time: 10.00 – 16.00 hours

A 6 hours tour exploring the major sites of Copenhagen and the former capital of Denmark, Roskilde.

City of Copenhagen: The Royal Castle, Amalienborg, New Harbour, Old Stock Exchange Christiansborg Castle, The Parliament.

City of Roskilde: The Fjord. The Vikingship Museum. The City square for lunch, The mindblowing world famous Roskilde Cathedral with the old graves and treasures.
