Christian Furrer reported for group no. 4 that there are still some questions open that will be discussed with the relevant contact persons in the associations.

For group no. 1 Henning Wergen reported that a general view on all associations had been formed with some final clarity still being needed.

Furthermore, Henning Wergen informed that the IFoA has sent in its self-assessment. Group no. 2 will review the IFoA spreadsheet, Petr Bohumsky agreed to support group no. 2. Henning Wergen also mentioned that the Actuarial Association of Iceland reported back that they have no own education system that needs reviewing.

It was briefly discussed that it might make sense to have a legal check on the process and the documentation of the outcome to ensure the robustness of the MRA. Henning Wergen will discuss this with the AAE Board.
