The Actuarial Association of Europe admits its 5th Observer Member Association

Brussels, 11 October 2023: The Actuarial Association of Europe is pleased to announce that it has admitted the <u>Actuarial Association of Moldova</u> (Asociaţia de Actuariat din Moldova, AAM), as its 5th Observer Member Association. The AAM was established in January 2007, has a membership comprising 12 fully qualified actuaries and is currently led by President Oleg Verejan.

The AAM objectives include:

- Contribution to recognition, support and promoting the actuary profession in the Republic of Moldova;
- Affirmation and defense of the rights of all actuaries or persons professionally assimilated to those operating in the Republic of Moldova;
- Acquiring and spreading knowledge in the actuarial field.

Admission as an Observer Member requires the approval of the AAE General Assembly. At its last meeting, held on 6 October 2023, the General Assembly unanimously approved the application of AAM to become an AAE Observer Member.

This activity contributes towards achieving the AAE's strategic objective to promote a European community of actuaries.
