#### Transportation to Edinburgh City Centre

#### 1. Direct transport from Edinburgh Airport:

- **Airlink 100 bus**: Runs every 10 minutes, operating 24 hours a day. The journey takes around 30 minutes, with stops at key points in the city center.
- **Trams**: Edinburgh Trams run every 7 minutes from the airport to the city center (St. Andrew Square) and take about 35 minutes.
- Night buses: The N22 runs between the airport and city center from 00:45 to 04:15.

#### 2. Taxis from Edinburgh Airport to city center:

- Available directly outside the Arrivals Terminal. Approximate fare is £25-£30, and taxis accept cash and card payments.
- Alternatively, use ride-hailing apps like **Uber** or **Bolt**.

#### Edinburgh Castle

Perched atop Castle Rock, this iconic fortress offers stunning views over the city and a deep dive into Scottish history. Don't miss the Crown Jewels and the Stone of Destiny.

#### The Royal Mile

A walk down this historic street, which connects Edinburgh Castle to Holyrood Palace, offers a glimpse of Edinburgh's medieval heart. It's lined with shops, cafes, and important historical sites.

#### Arthur's Seat

For the adventurous, hike up this extinct volcano in Holyrood Park. At the summit, enjoy panoramic views of Edinburgh and beyond.

#### **National Museum of Scotland**

Discover Scotland's rich history, from prehistoric times to the present day, at this free-to-enter museum located near the Royal Mile.
