Actuarial Association of Europe appoints Bogdan Tautan as Chairperson AAE Risk Management Committee

The Actuarial Association of Europe (AAE) has announced the result of the electronic vote for the position of Chairperson of the AAE Risk Management Committee.

Following the electronic vote of the AAE General Assembly having ended on 4 March 2025, the AAE confirms the appointment of **Bogdan Tautan** (The Netherlands) as Chairperson of the AAE Risk Management Committee by unanimous vote.

Bogdan will fulfil the remainder of the term of the previous Chairperson, Loudina Erasmus, until the General Assembly of 2026.

Bogdan is a member of the Dutch Association (Koninklijk Actuarieel Genootschap) and a Dutch national with Romanian roots. He has extensive experience in risk management, along with creativity, leadership and vision. Bogdan is Senior Reinsurance Actuary & Capital Analyst at Achmea Reinsurance in The Netherlands and has been active in the AAE since 2021 in the Artificial Intelligence and Data Science Working Group, currently as co-vice chair.

Being active on a national level in the Dutch Actuarial Association in various roles as well as on a global level in the IAA, where he chairs the Artificial Intelligence Governance Adoption Framework, part of the Artificial Intelligence Task Force, the AAE recognizes Bogdan's strong commitment to advance the actuarial profession.
