Transportation to Limassol City Centre

1. From Larnaca International Airport (LCA) to Limassol:

Larnaca Airport is the nearest international airport to Limassol, approximately 65 km away.

• Airport Shuttle Buses (Kapnos Airport Shuttle):

- Direct shuttle service from Larnaca Airport to central Limassol.
- Journey time: approx. 1 hour
- Tickets: around €10–€12
- Schedules and booking: www.kapnosairportshuttle.com

• Private Transfers / Hotel Shuttles:

- Many hotels offer pre-arranged transfers; check with your hotel directly.
- Private taxi transfers can also be booked in advance.

• Taxis from the Airport:

- Available at the arrivals terminal.
- Approximate fare to Limassol: €55–€70 depending on time of day
- Travel time: approx. 45–60 minutes
- Note: Taxis in Cyprus generally accept cash; confirm card payment availability in advance.

2. **From Paphos International Airport (PFO):**

An alternative airport, approximately 60 km from Limassol.

- **Intercity Buses or Shuttle Services:**

- Journey time: 45–60 minutes
- Shuttle or taxi options similar to Larnaca
- Fare: approx. €60–€70 by taxi

- **Car Rental:**

- Available at both airports and it may be convenient if you plan to explore the island during your stay.
- **Remember: driving is on the left in Cyprus.**

Places to Visit in Limassol

Limassol Old Town

Stroll through the charming streets of the Old Town, where you'll find traditional architecture, vibrant cafés, and artisan boutiques. Don't miss the beautifully renovated Limassol Castle, now home to the Medieval Museum.

Limassol Marina

A modern seafront development where luxury yachts meet trendy restaurants and shops. It's a perfect place for a sunset walk or a relaxed evening by the sea.

Ancient Kourion

Just a short drive from the city, this ancient Greco-Roman site offers stunning views of the Mediterranean and well-preserved ruins, including a theatre and mosaics.

Limassol Promenade (Molos)

A scenic walkway lined with palm trees, sculptures, fountains, and playgrounds. Great for a jog, a relaxing stroll, or a coffee by the water.
